8.a Maintenance Agreements

Old Business Follow Up

T. Gilligan updated the Transportation Committee on the maintenance agreement with Municipality of Brighton. Met with Brighton's Roads Manager and went over the 5 shared roads. This will come before council as soon as the agreement has been reviewed by all parties.

8.b Downtown Parking

Old Business follow up

Committee discussion on the King Street parking lot now that Circle K is burned down and fenced in. Now have the parking lot beside the Municipal Office to ease parking congestion. Need to wait for decision of the Circle K corporation before any action is taken on the parking lot owned by the Township.

8.c Pine/Haynes Road

New Business

P. Kelly confirmed there is no shortage of calcium and will be moving towards a stronger solution to last longer.

Pine Street has been pulverized and will be surface treated by the end of the season from the County Road 22 to the dead end for 0.5 km.

Haynes Road has been pulverized and will be surfaced treated from County Rd 25 heading east for 1.2 km.

8.d Meeting Frequency

New Business

Committee is struggling to meet on a regular basis. Need to meet at least quarterly and can have informal meetings in between as needed. All ratifications are to come to the formal quarterly meeting.

8.e Street Lighting

T. Gilligan updated the Transportation Committee that there is 1 pole left to replace, and the pole in front of lawyers office to be looked at.

8.f budget Review

budegted 200,000 for catchbasins and man holes. Hope is to do 100 of the poor catch basins and man holes.

8.g Sidewalk Upgrades Schedule

Staff updated the Transportation Committee on the sidewalk upgrades. Township will be focusing on the County Road stretch because there has never been a boulevard and there are issues with amount of County snow. There will be a report to Council regarding sidewalks on Durham Street and Parliament. For Durham Street, need people off the road during the construction period.

8.h Colborne Creek Walkways

Discussion on the Elgin Street pedestrian bridge and progress. P. Kelly outlined his bridge plan.

8.i Ditching and Roadwork Schedule

P. Kelly provided an update on the road schedule for 2025. Staff are out sweeping the roads but seeing less sand on the roads. Cramahe Township is lined up to be the first completed for surface treatment.
