Committee co-ordinates the maintenance, snow-removal, grading, and upkeep of McDonald Rd. in Cramahe Township. A grant would benefit approximately 100 residents from 50 properties, in addition to employing snowplowing and grading businesses in the community.


The project provides business/employment for snowplowing and grading services in our local economy.
