- We are a privately owned facility that is operated and maintained by volunteers. This grant helps to offset the operating costs so we can continue to offer a wide variety of activities.
- We currently offer soccer, yoga, volleyball, pickleball, a walking trail,
- our yoga program uses the Castleton Town Hall
- Castleton 3 Pitch league uses the ball diamonds from May -September
- in the winter months , weather permitting we have outdoor skating rinks and a crok-n-curl playing surface
- We rent our diamonds for various fundraising activities
- Northumberland Hills PS uses the fields for their physical education programs
- We are currently working towards being able to convert one of our soccer pitches into an outdoor pickleball court, a beach volleyball court and a basketball court so that we can offer additional activities that are free for the community to use
- we also organize a run an annual fishing derby for children that is hosted at the Ryken family farm.
- Our sun shelter has been used by families following loved ones funerals at the cemetery
- we host a soccer festival that brings in families from Lindsay, Peterborough, Cavan and Northumberland (12 teams of 10 children + their families)
- we have also recently offered K9 obedience classes as a trial to see if there was an interest in the community, many people bring their pets to the fields for exercise so we thought this might be another opportunity to fundraise.

What is the projected number of Cramahe residents that this funding would benefit?

Our facility is open to all residents of Cramahe township and the surrounding area.

- our soccer program has families from Cramahe, Warkworth, Grafton , Baltimore and Roseneath. We have 65-130 children registered.

- Castleton 3 Pitch has participants from the same areas as well as Brighton. They had 12 teams participate this season.
